

REP Waiting Area Map

Attached below are pictures of the REP waiting area and their designated locations. Please review the important information below to ensure you find the correct waiting area location when it is time to participate in an experiment:

- **Locations:** REP in-person studies usually take place on the Ground, 1st, or 2nd floor in the Psychology Building (PS) or in Lazenby (LZ). There are usually chairs and a sign to let you know you are in the correct place.
- **Be Considerate of Others:** When you are in the waiting area, please considerate to others who may be working in offices nearby
- **Be On Time:** It is also very important that you are on time. Even if you are a minute late the session may have already started and you'll be counted as absent for that session.
- **Wait For A Researcher:** Once you are in the waiting area, someone from the research team will come to call you for the session.
- **Wait For Your Name To Be Called:** Many researchers use the same waiting area and multiple researchers may be calling at the same time. If one person comes out and doesn't call your name, don't worry. Someone will be there shortly to call your name. Also be sure to listen for your name and be sure to take out any headphones/earphones so you can hear your name be called.
- **It is your responsibility as a student participant to arrive at the waiting area prior to the session starting time in the same way that students must find the location of their classrooms during the semester. If you are not in the correct area at the start of your session, you will be counted as absent for that session.**

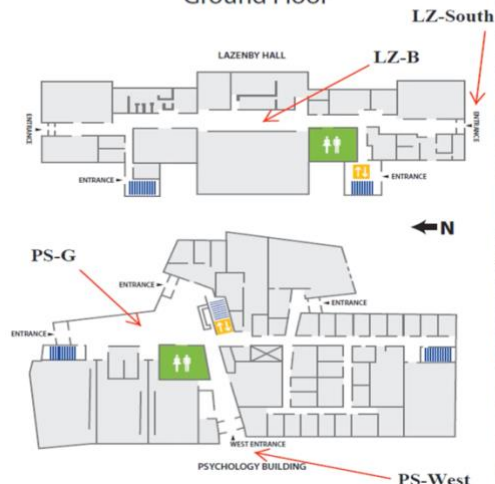


REP Office

Researchers will meet you in the waiting area indicated on your schedule. For questions, see the REP Office.

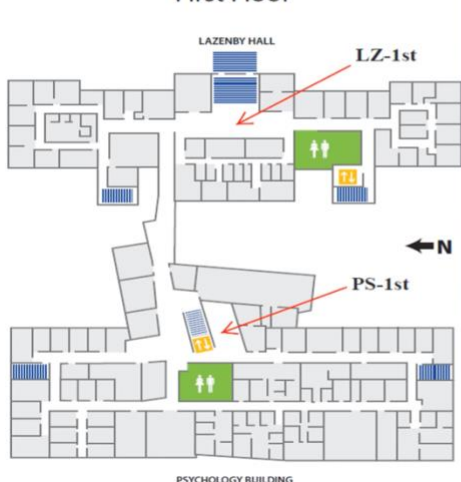
Ground Floor



Ground/Basement Floor:

- The “ground” floor (G) or basement floor (B) is the level that sits directly on the ground/street entry.
- This is the first floor you walk into when entering the Psychology Building and Lazenby Hall (unless accessing Lazenby from the front steps facing the library).
- **LZ-B:** Waiting area is in the main hallway in the middle of Lazenby Hall.
- **PS-G:** Waiting area is in the main area across from the restrooms.

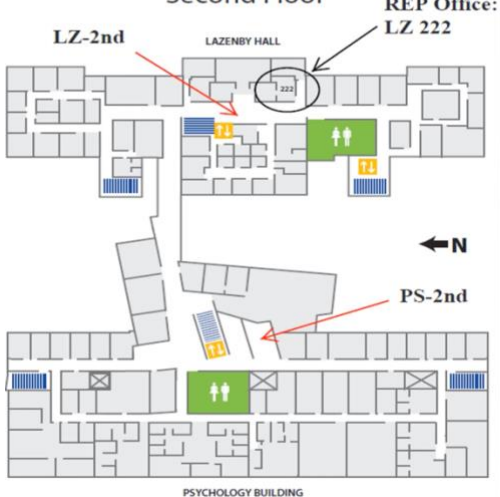
First Floor



First Floor:

- **LZ-1:** The 1st floor waiting area in Lazenby Hall (LZ-1) is located directly in front of the main stairs into Lazenby.
- **PS-1:** The 1st floor waiting area in the Psychology Building (PS-1) is located next to the elevators. If you take the elevator up, this will be to your left. If you take the stairs up to the 1st floor, you should take a left and go to the area behind the stairs and across from the restrooms.

Second Floor



Second Floor:

- The 2nd floor waiting areas in both the Psychology Building (PS-2) and Lazenby Hall (LZ-2) are in the same locations as they are on the first floor, just up a level.
- **LZ-2:** The 2nd floor waiting area in Lazenby Hall (LZ-2) is in the middle of the main hallway close to the stairs and elevators.
- **PS-2:** The 2nd floor waiting area in the Psychology Building (PS-2) is located beside the elevators. If you take the elevator up, this will be to your left. If you take the stairs up to the 2nd floor, you should take a left and go to the area behind the stairs and across from the restrooms.
