

REP Website Tutorial – Students

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Choosing your REP Option

1. Log into the REP website (<https://rep.psy.ohio-state.edu/>) using your regular OSU login credentials.
2. The first time you log into the REP website you will be asked to select either the Research (Experiment) option or Paper option and to accept the terms and conditions.
3. Make sure you type **today’s date** (NOT your birthday) in the box that says “I accept these terms as of:” Your computer may insert a date placeholder in there, but unless you manually select today’s date you will not be able to access the REP website.

- I understand that REP staff cannot direct me to sessions if I arrive late, per Psychology Department Guidelines.
- I understand the researcher may call my name up to 10 minutes after my session start time and I should wait in the waiting area. After 10 minutes, I can go to the REP Office to discuss the matter or email the researcher directly.
- I understand that this contract highlights major points from the REP Experiment Option Syllabus. I will read the entire document for further clarity and that I am accountable for all information in the syllabus.
- I understand that the Research Experience Program is intended to help me learn how psychological research is conducted. By participating in experiments I will gain direct experience with the topics, goals, methods, and ethical issues of psychological research.

4. You can change your REP option at any point before the deadline by clicking the “My Info” tab. Click the “Edit User Profile” button and select either the “Paper” or “Research” option.

Changing your Personal Information

1. Begin by clicking the “My Info” tab.
2. Click the “Edit User Profile” button. You can change the following information at any point during the semester (Note: Please provide your full name and demographic information. Researchers will rely on the information you provided to find eligible participants for their studies):
 - a. First Name
 - b. Last Name
 - c. Gender
 - d. Ethnicity

Completing Prescreenings (for Extra Credit)

1. Begin by clicking the “My Info” tab.
2. On this screen you will see your Enrollments and your Assigned Prescreenings.

3. **Assigned Prescreenings:** In the “Complete?” column next to each prescreening you will see either “Yes” or a link that says “Take Prescreening.” Once you have completed a prescreening, the link will be replaced by “Yes.”
4. You must complete **ALL of the prescreenings assigned** to you in order to earn your two points of extra credit. When all prescreenings are completed, your extra credit points will appear in the “extra credit” section of “Points Earned” at the top of your “My Info” page.

Signing up for and Completing Experiments

1. Begin by clicking the “Experiments” tab.
2. By default, you’ll be shown a list of available experiments. Click on one of the experiment names to see additional details and sign up for a session.

9. **Online Experiments:** Sometimes the experiment link will be available as soon as you sign up for the experiment, but sometimes the researcher will want to email you the link on a specific day. Please read the experiment description to see how the researcher would like you to complete the experiment.
 - a. If the link is available right away, you can click on the word “Online” under “Location” on your “My Info” page to access the experiment. You can also click on the name of the experiment to bring up the description page, then the link can be found on the left-hand side of the page under “Experiment link.”
 - b. If the link is not available right away, read the experiment description to see when you should expect it to be emailed to you. It might show up in your Junk email folder. If you have not received the link by the experiment start time, feel free to email the experimenter by clicking on their name on the experiment description page.
10. Once you have been given credit for an experiment you will see a link named “Complete Qualtrics Survey” in the “Actions” column. Please complete the brief survey for each experiment you complete. This information helps us make sure that researchers are treating you fairly and whether their experiment helped you learn more about how psychological research is conducted.
 - a. This survey is NOT the link for online experiments. Completion of this survey is separate from experiment participation.

Accepting Experiment Invitations

1. If a researcher has invited you to complete an experiment, it can be found under the “Invitations” tab on the “Experiments” page.

2. To accept the invitation, click the button that says “Register.” This will bring you to the experiment page with a list of available sessions at specific times.
3. Click the button that says “Sign Me Up” to enroll in that session of the experiment. It will now appear on your “My Info” page with your other experiments.

Cancelling Experiment Appointments

1. Begin by clicking the “My Info” tab.
2. If the experiment start time is MORE than two hours away, you can cancel your appointment by clicking the “Withdraw” button in the “Actions” column.

- If the experiment start time is LESS than two hours away, you can cancel your appointment by emailing the researcher. They will be able to drop the experiment for you.
 - Click on the experimenter's name (on the experiment description page) to find the researcher's email address

Checking your REP Credit

- Begin by clicking the "My Info" tab.
- You can see a summary of your points at the top of the page next to "Points Earned." This summary is divided into "regular" and "extra credit" points
 - Regular – this shows you your progress towards your required 28 REP points (12 points for Honors students)
 - Extra credit – this shows you how many extra credit points you have earned. Once you have earned your required points, additional points will appear here. Extra credit points earned from prescreening (2 points) will also appear here.
- You do not earn points for any sessions you miss, but they do stay in your schedule as marked absences.

- WARNING:** If you are **marked absent for 2 consecutive sessions, your account will be temporarily suspended or frozen**, and you will not be permitted to sign up for any additional sessions. You will have *one week* to contact the REP Office to request that your account be unfrozen. If you do not, you will automatically be switched to the Paper Option, with the points that you have earned through research participation transferred over.

Once your account has suspended, you will receive an email titled "**REP Account Suspended.**" You should email REP **within ONE WEEK** to unfrozen your account
